STYLISH SELF-SEALING PORT USES NO CAULKING

The old "caulk and putty is our best buddy" adage is often used when replacing existing port windows, and sometimes even when installing new ones. To ensure a leak-free installation and an attractive appearance, New Found Metals offers its new caulk-less, lightweight and self-sealing Tri-Matrix port.

The port uses high-density, closed-cell foam that seals tightly to the cabin wall. Compressed when the port is through-bolted, this seal creates a water-tight installation between the unit's high-strength body and attractive finishing ring. With hinges and dogs that fully adjust for cabin thickness and gasket pressure, the port eliminates the chance of leaking, even under the most severe conditions.

Constructed of 316/316L stainless steel and ASA, weather-resistant polymers, the window also tends to form much less condensation than conventional all-metal ports. The Tri-Matrix is offered in 5" x 12", 7" x 15" and 8"-round glass sizes. Standard glazing is 8-mm acrylic, but 8-mm laminated and tempered glass is also available on special order.
