### NEW DECK FITTING MAKES WASHDOWNS EASY

Marine accessory manufacturer New Found Metals of Port Townsend, Washington, is pleased to announce that ITT/Jabsco will now distribute its stainless steel, deck washdown fitting. Its patented design allows quick connection and disconnection of a hose from the water supply, even under full pressure. The fitting can even be used to control incoming pressure water to an engine flush valve.

The washdown fitting consists of two pieces: a 316 stainless steel fitting that is flush-mounted in the deck or bulkhead; and a positive-lock, bayonet adapter with double Viton O-rings that attaches to the end of the hose. The hose can then be removed easily from the deck fitting with a simple twist, eliminating the need to turn off the water when disconnecting the hose. A built-in check valve eliminates leakage.

The back of the deck-mounted connector has a ½" female-NPT fitting that attaches to the pressure-pump supply line, while the blue hose adapter accepts American standard garden hose threads. Additional adapters for multiple hoses can be purchased separately.

New Found Metal's flush-mount deckwash is provided as standard equipment on 37' and 42' Nordic Tugs, and as an option on the 32'

model. Nordic's President Ric Reid reports, "We love the design and quality of the product."

The deckwash is also offered as optional equipment on all Cabo Yachts' models. Leo Hernandez, one of Cabo's buyers, said, "We like the deckwash because it's easy to install. It has a clean look, and customers don't have to worry about bumping into it."

New Found Metals' washdown fitting is now available through Jabsco dealers and most marine chandleries (Jabsco part #31911), and retails for \$69.95.
