PORT WINDOWS SCREENS ARE EASY TO INSTALL AND REMOVE

To keep flying critters outside where they belong, port window screens should fit snugly. But they still need to be easily removable for window cleaning. New Found Metals now offers a new, tight fitting screen for selected ports that snaps in and out without the use of tools—from the inside.

Unlike nylon or chrome, the screen's electro-polished, stainless steel mesh will not deteriorate or discolor. The gasket is constructed of EPDM, the same material used on auto windshields, which seals firmly and quickly against the port's main frame and spigot.

To install the screen, simply use a butter knife, coin or any flat object to tuck the lip of the screen's gasket into the main frame of the window. Then adjust the height of the upper posts and lower cam-dog posts to form a tight seal to the gasket. To remove, gently pull the screen out and readjust the top and bottom posts so that the glass frame seals securely to the port's main frame.

The new screens are designed to fit all New Found Metals stainless and Trimatrix opening ports.
