### DECK WASHDOWN HAS A NEW TWIST

Stretching and connecting the hose before washing a boat can be a time consuming chore. To take the hassle out of connecting and disconnecting the hose, New Found Metal's deck washdown fitting and connector make the job faster, easier and safer—even under full water pressure.

A 316 stainless steel wash valve is flush-mounted to the deck or bulkhead, and connects to the onboard water supply. A blue, positive-lock bayonet connector with double Viton O-rings mounts on the hose and mates securely to the deck fitting with a simple twist.

To engage the connector with the deck valve, merely line up the arrow on the connector's handle with the ball-like protrusion inside the valve. Then, a quick, quarter-turn clockwise of the connector by hand mates the units securely. Installing a standard elbow fitting, available at most hardware stores, between the connector and the hose makes turning the connector easier. It also eliminates a 90°-bend in the hose.

The washdown fitting and connector are available through all ITT Flojet distributors for \$69.95 retail.
